From our By-Laws:

**3.2 VOTING PROCEDURES**

i. The officers shall be elected by a simple majority of the general membership present at the June General Membership Meeting. (A quorum is not required)

- ii. By the end of March, the President will, with the Board of Directors approval, appoint a Nominating Committee.
- iii. By April 15, the General Membership will be notified about nomination procedures and all deadlines.
- iv. On May 15, or such date set by the Nominating Committee, with the Parliamentarian's approval, nominations will be closed.
- v. The Nominating Committee shall submit names of all prospective candidates for each Office turning same over to Club Parliamentarian, after such approval, the Nominating Committee will publish and/or post the list of candidates for each position by May 15, or such date as approved by the Parliamentarian.
- vi. Contested Offices shall be voted by Secret Ballot.
- vii. The Secretary shall cast one vote for each uncontested Office.
- viii. In the event of a Tie vote, a re-vote will be taken that night by Ballot.
- ix. Only in the event that there are no candidates for any specific Office, the Secretary will accept nominations from the floor at the General Membership Meeting. If no one is nominated from the floor, the Board of Directors shall seek out a candidate to fill said Office, with approval of the BOD at the Next BOD Meeting.
- x. Members seeking election to Contested Office shall be allowed Five (5) Minutes to state their objectives and goals, and answer questions, and then will leave the Meeting until the Balloting is complete.
- xi. In any uncontested Office, the Secretary will record ONE (1) vote for each candidate as part of the election process, as if the candidate voted for himself or herself.
- xii. All members of the Board of Directors may vote in Elections.

3. Instructional Training – Jeff Sundelof - Discussion on better ways to train Instructional

Issues I think we currently have with Instructional training.

1. Coaches are not accountable and mostly uninvolved
2. Groups are too big (Some teams this season have 15 players)
3. Training is not specific to skill level.
4. Very difficult to schedule with lack of light in the Fall and early in Spring.
5. Sessions are typically not made up if cancelled for weather.
6. Parents grumble for refunds if sessions are not made up.
7. Trainers are disconnected from players because of large ratio.

My suggestions on how to train the program.

1. **Do not have mandatory training beyond U7:** From the U8 level up through Seniors, training will be offered as an option during the registration process at an additional cost. Option 1 is for experienced players who desire to develop more skill and possibly move on to travel. Option 2 is highly suggested for the first time player and players who need to learn basic soccer skills. *This will achieve a couple of things. Coaches will not be required to attend these sessions as there will be no affiliation to team. Players can be more easily separated into skill appropriate groups. Players can also be more easily separated into a proper sized player/trainer ratios. Training company will be responsible for scheduling make up sessions or refunding for lack thereof. My other suggestion would be to have to price tiers for the training-50.00 for option 1 and 40.00 for option 2.*
2. **Instructional coaches will be given an on field Coach Clinic before the start of each season.** *This will be run and scheduled by the Instructional Head Coach or one of the Instructional VP's in their absence. This informational session will put coaches on the field to explain the rules of the game to the first time or inexperienced coach.*
3. **Little kickers will have 2 soccer festival events.** *I stole this from Chuck. I think that the parents and kids would get a kick (no pun intended) out of seeing their child attempt to apply some of the skills they are learning in a actual game format.*
4. **U6 and U7 have mandatory training.** *Training for these age groups is mandatory. There will be 2 choices during registration, Basic or Experienced. Basic is for the first time player or players that need more focus on basic soccer skills. Experienced is for more experienced players who are looking to develop more skill. Every player will be put into Basic training in the Fall of the U6 season. Or we could budget to have a 1 trainer per team ratio as they do in travel. Team sizes are aprox. 9-11 players currently.*

7. Chuck Myers - Uniform orders can be made EASIER.

While at the NSCAA annual convention in Jan, I meet Joe's contact at Eurosport/Soccer.com. They have a new offering where they set up a web page for us, we link to it off of our PSC.org site, and then we tell parents to go buy their son's/daughter's uniform. It gets shipped directly to the home address. After we set this up, the coach just has to tell the parent what jersey number to use (e.g., #14) so there isn't a duplicate on the team. Then it is all up to the parent. We don't have to make bulk orders (but we still get the bulk discount). Soccer.com will do what AKA does for us now, which is add the number on the back of the jersey and add the club logo to the front. Want the number on the shorts? no problem. The only restriction is that the club decides the format. So, if we don't go with names on the back, then they cannot be ordered. Same uniform, same overall look. Anything special, like sponsorship logo, would have to be done afterwards (kind of like now), where the Team manager gathers all the jerseys and takes them to AKA (if we say this is okay).

**BTW - our uniform style and color may NOT be available next fall.** Has it been 3 years already? We should probably start looking for a new style for new teams that form in the fall. (FYI - I have some AL kits left over from the Inferno when you need them...really cheap....really) I would be willing to help here. Feb 2011 – BOD agreed to proceed. Chuck Myers to set up. BOD to review and confirm to proceed with vote at March BOD Meeting.

8. Chuck Myers - We eventually need a new web site (perhaps done in the spring/summer). I say this because if we want to be a better club, then part of that is looking the part. This will eventually attract more in-town players, but more out-of town players as well. Our needs are

- + Online registration (using family accounts)
- + tournament management
- + team pages + able to email the entire club, or just a team, or just an age group.
- + and all of the other stuff that we currently have, just made to look better

+ \$3.50/player registration (only slightly cheaper today)  
+ Store tab, buy soccer gear via Eurosport / soccer.com, PSC get 5% back  
- no tournament software.

9. Chuck Myers - New fall registration rate increase by ??? for both travel and instructional. \$50 may be too steep, but \$15-25 increase per year for the next 5 years may be easier. Need this for: - club expenses are going up, cost of balls, nets, etc. - Training expenses will go up in the fall. (I was going to increase to \$80/hr this past fall, but decided to push this back to Fall 2011. This will be 2G's first ever increase.) - new website (about \$4/player + registration costs of \$2.50 or \$3.50 (per season) + credit card ~3%) The instructional players are basically paying this already, this isn't as big a change as you might think. - turf field, we have to start saving for a down payment
